- Allows to get an impression about the place, where shooting was effected
- Allows to manage and zoom the view by keyboard and mouse
- Very high resolution of photos
- Small size of files compare to video
- Can be viewed inside the Browser on Desktop (Windows, Mac, Linux) and on Mobiles/Tablets (iPhone, iPad, Android, ...).

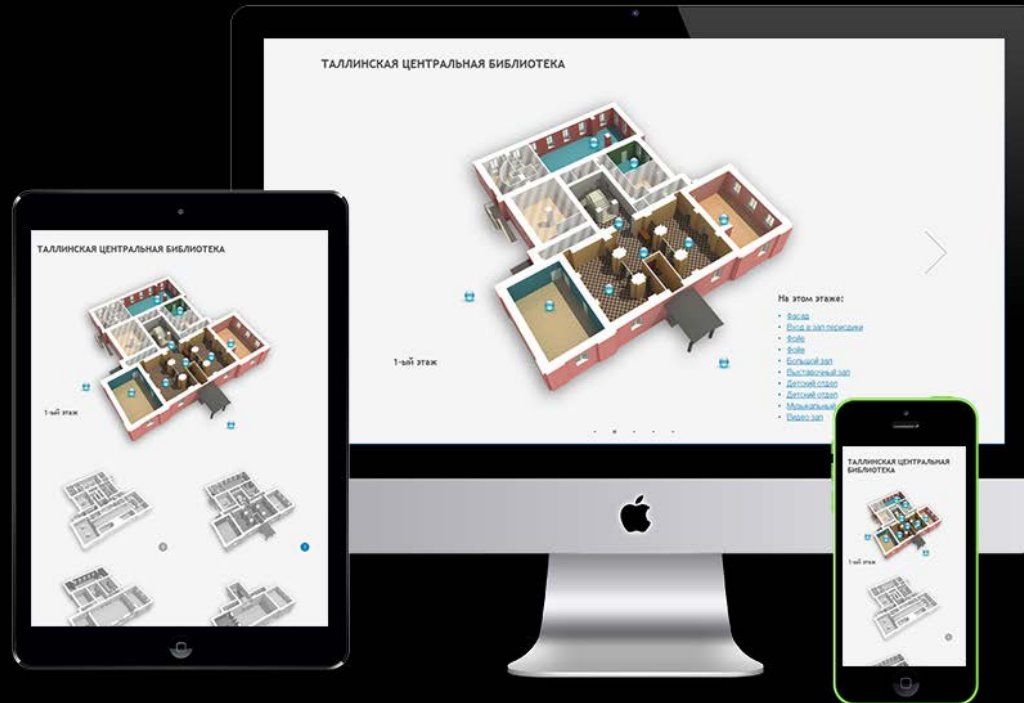

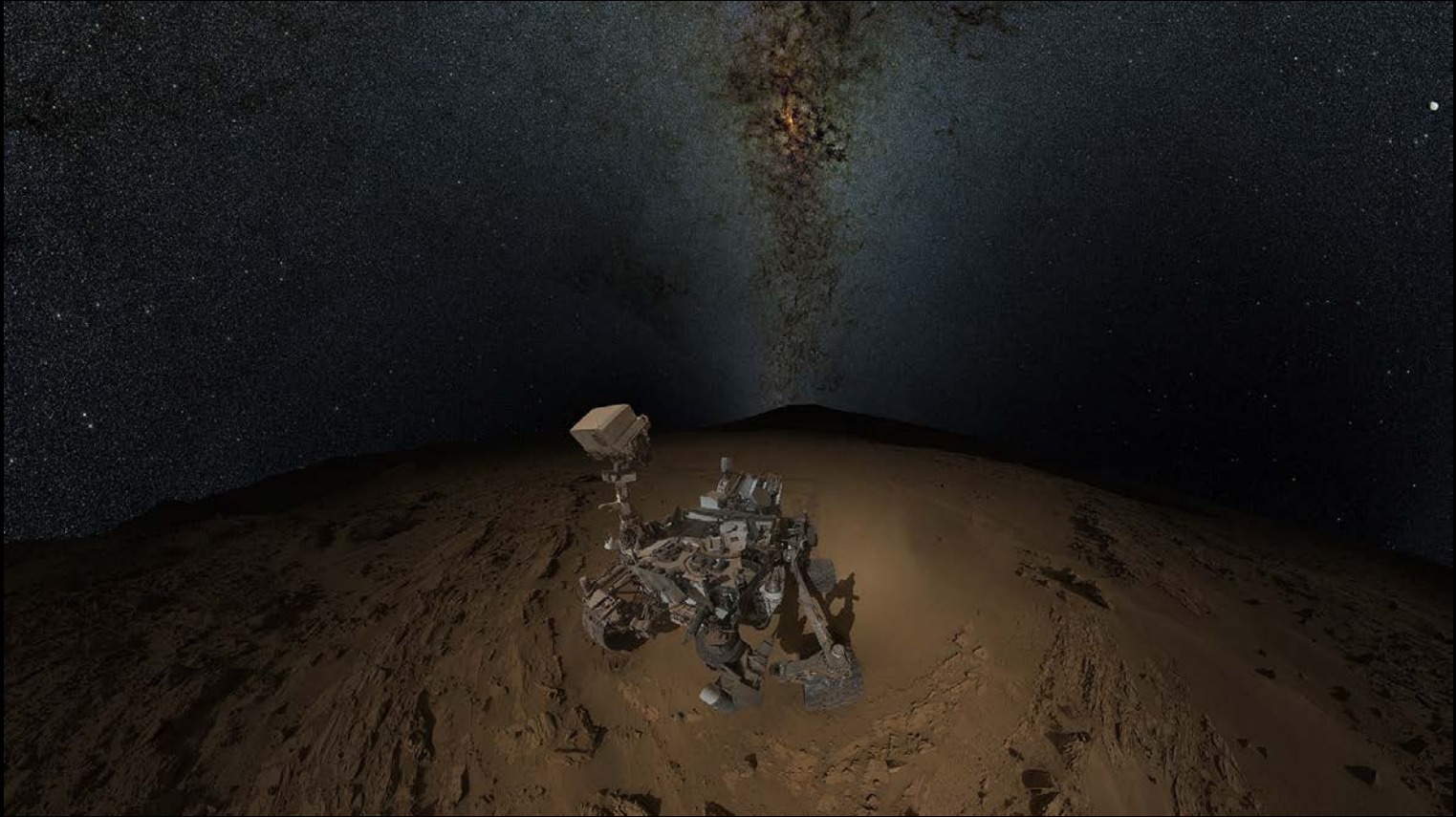
Baikonur (Roscosmos)
